Re: Four Year College Scholarship

The Saint Paul College Club, Inc., American Association of University Women Scholarship Trust (hereafter, Trust) is offering **\$ 4,000 scholarships for the 2012-2013 academic year**. These awards are renewable for three years provided the recipient remains a full-time student in an accredited four-year college and maintains at least a B average.

The scholarships are available to high school senior women from Saint Paul and Saint Paul suburban public or private high schools who are in the upper one-fifth of their class and plan to attend any accredited four-year college or university. **The Scholarship Trust will select young women on the basis of financial need, SAT/ACT scores, scholastic achievement, school and community activities.**

One of these scholarships may be awarded to a senior woman participant in the Admission Possible program.

One of these scholarships may be awarded in the name of Lilian Osborn to a student who shows promise in poetry, submits 3 poems and has the recommendation of her English teacher.

The written recommendation of a teacher or counselor is required in the evaluation.

Each high school may recommend up to three applicants and **may assist** each applicant **with** the following **required** forms:

- 1. Scholarship application**
- 2. Social Security Number**
- 3. Federal income tax copies of the high school student and her parents/guardian OR a complete copy of FAFSA (Explain any financial factors that affect the applicant's need for financial help. All financial data from applicants will be treated confidentially and will be destroyed following consideration.)**
- 4. Academic Record Release and Applicant Summary form**
- 5. A letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor**

All forms must reach the St. Paul College Club, Inc., AAUW Scholarship Trust, 990 Summit Avenue, Saint Paul, MN 55105 by **March 15, 2012**. The finalists will be interviewed in **April** and notified of the results by **April 20, 2012**.
