Re: Four Year College Scholarship

The Saint Paul College Club, Inc., American Association of University Women Scholarship Trust (hereafter, Trust) is offering up to four \$3,000 scholarships for the 2010-2011 academic year. These awards are renewable for three years provided the recipient remains a full-time student in an accredited four-year college and maintains at least a B average.

The scholarships are available to high school senior women from Saint Paul and Saint Paul suburban public or private high schools who are in the upper one-fifth of their class and plan to attend any accredited four-year college or university. The Scholarship Trust Committee will select up to four young women on the basis of financial need, SAT/ACT scores, scholastic achievement, school and community activities.

One of these scholarships may be awarded to a senior woman participant in the Admission Possible program.

One of these scholarships may be awarded in the name of Lilian Osborn to a student who shows promise in poetry, submits 3 poems and has the recommendation of her English teacher.

The written recommendation of a teacher or counselor is required in the evaluation.

Each high school may recommend up to three applicants and shall submit for each applicant the following forms:

1. Scholarship application
2. FAFSA copy or federal income tax copy
3. Academic Record Release and Applicant Summary form
4. A letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor
5. A transcript of grades and test scores

All forms must reach the St. Paul College Club, Inc., AAUW Scholarship Trust, 990 Summit Avenue, Saint Paul, MN 55105 by **March 15, 2010**. The finalists will be interviewed in late April and notified of the results by May 1, 2010.
